Edward Harper's *Fantasia V* was premièred at the Festival in 1985 by the Scottish Chamber Orchestra, and is based on a bogus Edinburgh postcode consisting of the composer's and his wife's initials. Its performance here is a fitting tribute to this eminent Scottish-based composer, who died last year.

The rest of the programme brings Mozart to the fore with one of his best loved concertos, often known as the *Elvira Madigan*, and his final work, the dark and exquisite Requiem.
